

However, you may refer to para 11 (iii) on 'Guidelines for the purpose of opening/ operating bank accounts of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation, Mental Illness and Mental Disabilities' and para 11.1 (ii) on 'Display of information regarding Local Level Committees set up under the National Trust for the Welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities Act, 1999' of our Master Circular DBR No. Leg.BC. 21/09.07.006/2015-16 dated July 1, 2015 on 'Customer Service in Banks'.</p> <p>(The circular is available on our website www.rbi.org.in under the link 'Notifications')</p>

The National Trust Act states that Legal Guardianship is issued only after attaining the age of 18 years of persons with National trust disabilities but banks are asking certificate for below 18 years of age.
